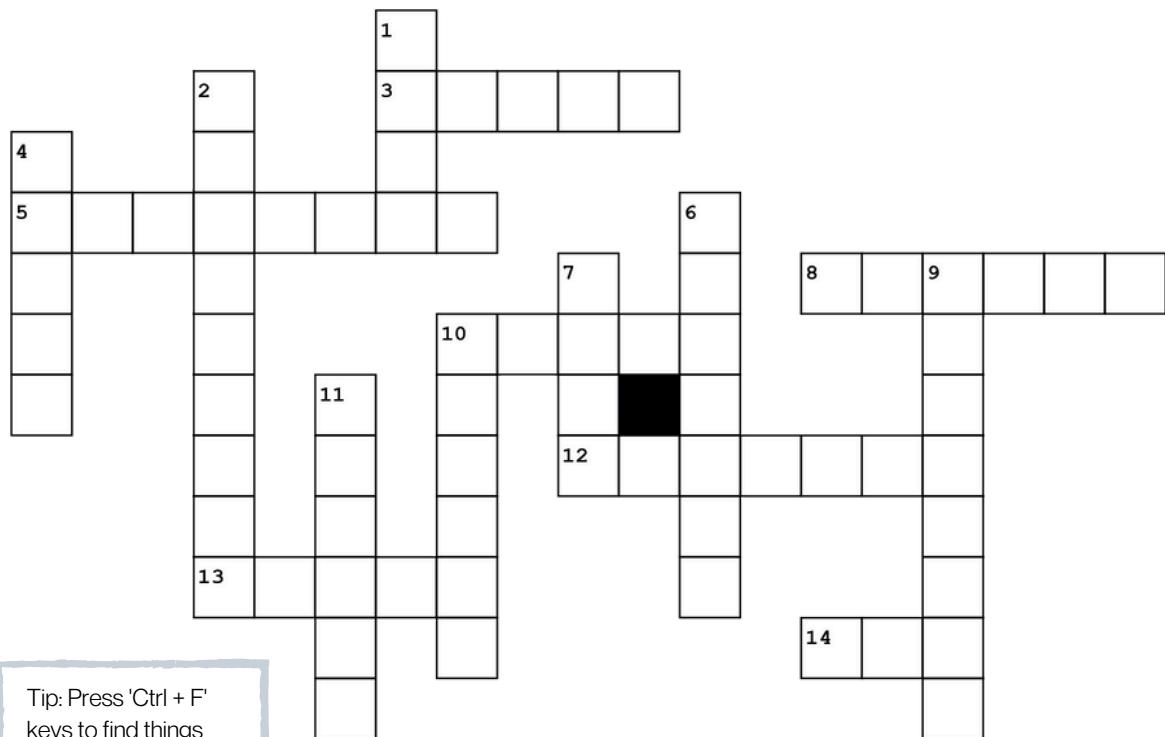


Britannica Library Fact-finder Crossword!
