

Task: Food Chain

Create a food chain for a specific ecosystem e.g. aquatic.



Tip: Start by making a list of all the organisms in your chosen habitat, including plants and animals.

First, write or draw the producers, like grass, trees, and cactus, which create their own energy, along the bottom.

Next place the primary consumers on the page. Primary consumers are creatures that feed and prey on producers.

Then, add in the secondary consumers. These are animals that are either meat-eating carnivores or meat and plant-eating omnivores.

Lastly, add tertiary consumers. These are creatures that prey upon the secondary consumers, primary consumers, and producers. They might not eat animals from all 3 of these categories, but they must eat secondary consumers to be considered tertiary.
