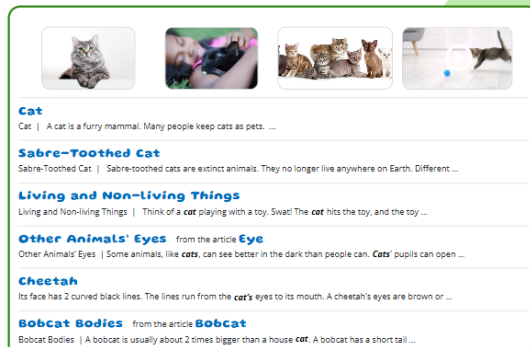

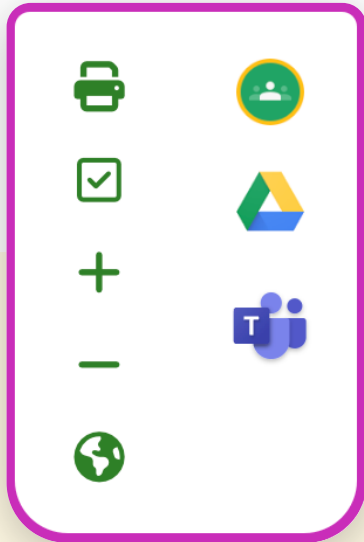


Search Bar

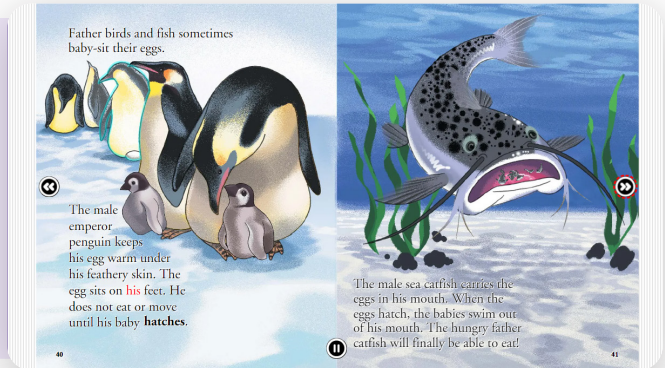
