Build Your Core Passage

- Once logged into Britannica Studio, click on the **Build It, Teach It** button.



Build It, Teach It

Create a passage, then access every tool in a single workflow.

- Select your year level and how long you want the passage of text to be.
- **Decide on your passage type:** Choose "Long Text" for in-depth exploration (ideal for historical analysis) or "Short Text" for quick overviews.

- Copy and paste your **curriculum codes** and **description** inside the text. You will see **"Add Suggested Topics?"** Click on the button and select the topics that will help you narrow down the focus of your content.

Once you have entered the topics, click "Generate".



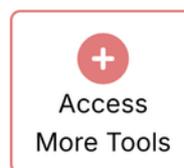
Treasure: A complete, verified passage from Britannica sources.

Level for Accessibility

- Go to "Access More Tools" (bottom left).
- Click "Level It."
- Select a lower reading level (e.g., Year 5) and click "Generate."
- Repeat for other levels if needed.



Treasure: Differentiated passages for diverse learners.

STEP

3

Level for Accessibility



- Return to "Access More Tools."
- Click "Vocabulary Builder."

- Choose 15 words and include a matching quiz (hit the "Toggle" option).
- Click "Generate." You can edit as needed. **Edit** 

STEP 4

Create Vocabulary Resources



- Return to "Access More Tools."
- Click "Vocabulary Builder."
- Choose 15 words and include a matching quiz.
- Click "Generate." Edit as needed.



Treasure: Key vocabulary list and quiz to learn unit vocabulary.

STEP 5

Summarise Key Points



- Go back to "Access More Tools."
- Click "Summarise It."
- Select "Paragraphs", "Bullets", or a "Table" and click "Generate."
- Click on the "Images" tab (located next to the "Summary") - select an image to include in your summary.
- Check the "Sources" tab for Britannica article links.
- Edit your summary if needed.



Treasure: Visual summary table with images for better retention.

STEP
6

Assess Understanding



- From "Access More Tools," click the assessment tool (Assess It).
- Choose how many questions you want to include and click "Generate."
- Review questions, answers, and edit if required.



Treasure: Ready-to-use quiz with keys.

STEP
7

Export Your Package

- Click "Export" (top right). [Export](#)
- Choose your file format (e.g., PDF) and select all activities or individual activities. Save these on your computer.



Treasure: Downloadable lesson set for classroom use.
